

Hadley Standish:

Many know the name of **Captain Myles Standish** (1584-1656) as one the first passengers who arrived on the Mayflower in 1620. A descendent of Myles was **William Standish** (1770-1852),

Abigail, daughter of Miles and Sarah, died 15 June, 1802, aged 1 year, 8 months, 17 days.

Eliza, daughter of William and Ruth, died 13 July, 1818, aged 11 years, 11 months, 20 days.

Eliza B.,* daughter of William and Ruth, died 13 July, 1818, aged 12 years.

George B.,* born 31 August, 1801; died 24 October, 1882.

Henry O.,* son of George B. and Judith L., died 10 September, 1841, aged 7 years.

Job, died 29 June, 1842, aged 65 years, 7 months, 7 days.

Judith L.,* wife of George B., Esq., died 24 August, 1866, aged 64 years.

Miles, died 16 October, 1805, aged 37 years, 7 months.

Miles,* son of William and Ruth, died 18 April, 1843, aged 30 years.

Orrin, son of Hadley and Abigail, died 25 June, 1790, aged 11 months, 7 days.

Otis, son of William and Ruth, died 20 September, 1819, aged 1 year, 10 months, 10 days. [Also on William Standish monument.]

Ruth,* wife of William, died 11 July, 1867, aged 89 years, 6 months.

* All on William Standish monument.
